

## About Beddgelert



Beddgelert is renowned as one of the prettiest villages in North Wales, and is winner of many Village in Bloom competitions for Wales, Britain, and Europe.

Situated at the foot of Snowdon, the village centre is an ancient stone bridge near where two rivers meet, where stone houses are jumbled against each other below rocky outcrops, and riverside walks skirt tree-fringed rivers.

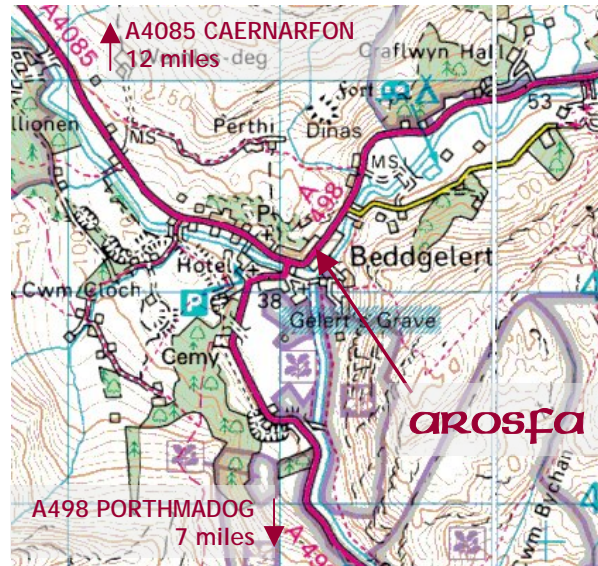


All around is spectacular scenery, a fascinating mix of mountains, lakes, woodlands, and streams.

For its size the village is unique, with 60 stone buildings being of listed status because of their architectural unity and historical interest.



Beddgelert is a great base from which to explore Snowdonia, and nearby is walking and climbing of all grades, spectacular sandy beaches, golf courses, great medieval castles at Harlech, Caernarfon, and Conwy, and several of the Great Little Trains of Wales.



**arosfa** is easy to find and is situated on the A498 Porthmadog - Capel Curig road, near the edge of the village.

If you are approaching from Capel Curig (ie you are coming down the valley of Nant Gwynant), **arosfa** is located in the second row of cottages on the right as you enter the village (opposite the bridge over the River Glaslyn).

If you are approaching from Porthmadog or Caernarfon, **arosfa** is located on the left in the second row of cottages on the left as you leave the village (opposite the bridge over the river).

Street parking is available outside the cottage.

# arosfa

Nestled in the pretty village of Beddgelert at the foot of Snowdon and opposite the River Glaslyn, **arosfa** is a Grade II listed stone-built copper miner's cottage.



Built in the 1830s but refurbished to an extremely high standard, **arosfa** (which means Rest Here in English) provides very comfortable holiday accommodation for 2 people.

Surrounded by mountains and stunning scenery, **arosfa** is an ideal base for a restful and relaxing holiday, and for exploring Snowdonia and the sights of North Wales.

Inside, is a sitting room with comfy seating, dining table and chairs, feature fireplace with log-burning stove, and outlook from the front window to the mountains.



A colour TV, DVD player, and CD player are provided.



The fully equipped kitchen includes a 2-ring ceramic hob, a high quality combi oven/microwave, overhead extractor fan, fridge, kettle, and toaster.

All cleaning equipment and tea towels are provided.

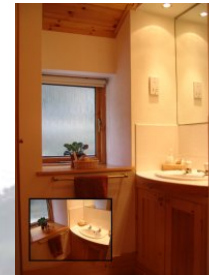
From the kitchen, a doorway leads into a utility room / drying room with a washing machine, tumble dryer, and freezer.

Upstairs is a spacious bedroom with 4ft double bed. There is plenty of storage with a walk-in wardrobe.



The view from the bedroom window looks out over the River Glaslyn and the mountains beyond. All bed linen is provided.

Upstairs there is also a bathroom with a bath and wash basin (towels are not provided), and a separate WC.



Outside at the rear, a door leads from the utility / drying room into the back garden, a private retreat backed by birch woodland on the mountain behind.

There is a patio / seating area with table and chairs, and views over the cottage to the nearby mountains.

- Fully equipped fitted kitchen with hob, and combi oven / microwave
- Utility / drying room with washing machine, tumble dryer, and freezer

- Double bedroom (4ft bed), plus bathroom, and separate WC
- All bed linen and tea towels provided
- Heating by night storage heaters (wood for the log burner is available locally)
- Available April - November, plus Xmas and New Year.

**arosfa** is less than 5 minutes walk from the centre of Beddgelert village. Local amenities include a store, a Post Office, three pubs, several restaurants and cafes, and an award-winning ice cream parlour.



## Booking Arrangements

Lets are from Saturday to Saturday - please vacate the cottage by 10am, arrive no earlier than 4pm. Wood for the log-burning stove is not supplied, but is available in the village. Electricity is extra by meter reading.

Sorry - no facilities for children (persons under 16), or pets. Non smoking. Please note there is no access through the cottage for bicycles.
